

Key Instant Recall Facts

Target 9

I know doubles and halves to 20.

By the end of this half term, you should know the following facts. The aim is to recall these facts **instantly**. You should also be familiar with using the key vocabulary.

$0 + 0 = 0$	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 0 = 0	$11 + 11 = 22$
$1 + 1 = 1$	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 2 = 1	$12 + 12 = 24$
$2 + 2 = 4$	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 4 = 2	$13 + 13 = 26$
$3 + 3 = 6$	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 6 = 3	$14 + 14 = 28$
$4 + 4 = 8$	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 8 = 4	$15 + 15 = 30$
$5 + 5 = 10$	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 10 = 5	$16 + 16 = 32$
$6 + 6 = 12$	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 12 = 6	$17 + 17 = 34$
$7 + 7 = 14$	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 14 = 7	$18 + 18 = 36$
$8 + 8 = 16$	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 16 = 8	$19 + 19 = 38$
$9 + 9 = 18$	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 18 = 9	$20 + 20 = 40$
$10 + 10 = 20$	$\frac{1}{2}$ of 20 = 10
