### Applying for a Year 7 place in secondary school for September 2020

Your child is due to move on to secondary school in September 2020 having completed the primary phase of their education. You now need to apply for a place at secondary school for your child.

### How to apply

The easiest and quickest way to apply is online at [www.northamptonshire.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.northamptonshire.gov.uk/admissions)  
Applications open on 10<sup>th</sup> September 2019. You will need to register using an email address.

You can also download a copy of the 'Applying for a Secondary School Place in Northamptonshire 2020/21' booklet from our website. Please read through the booklet before making your application.

Alternatively, you can apply using a paper preference form. You can request one from the School Admissions Team (contact details below).

Some schools require you to complete a supplementary information form (SIF) and/or your child to sit a common ability test (CAT). There is a list of schools which require a SIF on our website. SIFs should be returned directly to the school. It is important to be aware that some schools give priority to children who sit their common ability test, so those who do not sit the test will have less chance of getting a place.

### Closing date for applications

Your application must reach us by **5 pm on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019**. Failure to get your application in on time will affect your chances of obtaining a place for your child at your preferred schools.

### Pupils with an Education, Health and Care Plan

If your child has an EHC Plan, you do not need to apply for a school place using the process explained above. Instead, you will receive a letter from the EHC Team seeking details of your school preference.

### Pupils living outside of Northamptonshire

If your home address is outside of Northamptonshire (even if your child attends a Northamptonshire primary / junior school) you should apply to your home local authority. Contact details of other local authorities can be found on our website.
