



Mathematics
Year 3
We will be looking at length, mass and volume. We will be continuing to work on number bonds, place value and times tables.

Year 4
We will be looking at interpreting graphs, fractions and time. We will be continuing to work on number bonds, place value and times tables.

PSHE
In PSHE we will be looking at dreams and goals. This will include thinking about hopes and dreams, overcoming broken dreams and creating new dreams. In the following term, we will be looking at Being Healthy which will incorporate a healthy mind.

English
During the spring term, we will be exploring suspense stories. We will be reading and learning the text 'Zelda Claw and the Rain Cat' by Pie Corbett. They will be investigating the text structure and features resulting in writing their own exciting suspense stories. The children will be having spelling and handwriting lessons daily. The children will have a variety of opportunities to develop their love for reading at school including individually, in groups and comprehension activities.

PE.
Year 3 and 4 will be swimming on a Thursday afternoon during this term. We will be following the REAL PE scheme focusing on Gymnastics.

Spanish
In Spanish we will be learning about parts of the body. We will move on to looking at actions.

Geography
In geography the children will learn all about India. They will explore where it is located and what life is like in India.
We will also be making comparisons of geographical features in different countries, improving our map skills and learning how to use an eight point compass.

Computing
As well as continuing with our programming work, this term we will be looking at more basic computing skills. We will use word processing programs to build upon our skills this will include adding pictures and tables and building our knowledge of how to save and retrieve files.

Religious Education
In RE we will be thinking about Creation 'What do Christians learn from the creation story?' We will then move on to thinking about Salvation with a focus on Holy week 'Why do Christians call the day Jesus died good Friday?'
We will also be looking at what the Trinity means and looking for evidence of the Trinity in our local church.

Music
In music, we will be following the charanga scheme which includes vocal warmups, games and learning songs.

D&T / Art
This term we will be looking at the origins of Indian art and focusing on patterns so that we can create our own prints. We will also be working with clay and will produce our own Indian elephant sculptures.
In DT, we will be looking at the origins of Indian cooking. We will explore a variety of foods and then cook some of these dishes. We will end with a Pop Up restaurant!!

Science
In science we will be looking at forces and magnets, before moving on to investigating living things and their habitats, classifying plants and animals.
