





PHSE

Our unit is 'Dreams and Goals'. We will explore setting our own goals and working out how to achieve them.

We will be exploring obstacles which may make it difficult to achieve our goals and work out ways to overcome them.

Computing

Our key objective this term is developing children's skills in logging into Teams and exploring some of the tools available through this app.

RE

Our unit this term is Creation. We will explore how Christians believe that God Created the world in six days with the seventh day as a day of rest. We will look at how to look after our world and to take care of each other.

PE

Our PE this term focuses on dance. We will represent our ideas and feelings through dance and learn simple patterns of movement, developing awareness of rhythm. Year 2 will work on developing performance skills and repeated dance phrases.

Maths

This term, EYFS will use practical investigation based around the White Rose scheme to develop their early numeracy skills.

Year 1 and 2 will use Maths No Problem to support their learning. The focus will be to continue journaling and exploring numbers to 40, addition and subtraction, measuring height and weight.

English

Our English will focus on recount writing. We will get out and about in the locality to inspire our early work. Our final piece will centre around a mini sports morning.

EYFS will concentrate on constructing a when, where, what, who and how sentence. Year 1 will expand upon this by using time adverbials and Year 2 by applying adverbs, conjunctions and a concluding sentence.

Science

During this term, the children will identify and name a variety of common animals that are birds, fish, amphibians, reptiles and mammals. They will identify carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. They will label the basic parts of the human body and say which parts of the body is associated with each sense. They will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air).

History

Our History unit will focus on the reigns of Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II. We will compare their similarities and differences and learn vocabulary linked to the topic. We will look at where Queens live and what they do. We will learn why Victoria was important in the past and why our current queen Elizabeth II is important now.
