DOGS ON SCHOOL PREMISES

It has been noted that some parents are bringing their dogs onto the school site when dropping and/or collecting children. For health & safety reasons we would like to remind parents that, with the exception of registered working dogs, no dogs should be brought onto the school grounds. This is County Council Law.

It is good to encourage our children to walk to and from school each day. However, if you bring your dog to school, please ensure they are tied up well away from our playground entrance gates. Even the most placid dogs can become over excited and jump up at children. Some children can become worried should they have to pass closely to the dogs to access the school. No dogs, except guide dogs and hearing dogs, are allowed into the school grounds under any circumstances (including those dogs small enough to be carried).
