



## Years 3 & 4 Summer Term 2022

### History/ Geography

This term we have a history focus. We will be exploring local history, focusing on Elizabeth Woodville and comparing her to our current Queen Elizabeth. We will also be comparing life within these two time periods. The children will also be improving their chronology skills by creating timelines.

### English

This term's focus will be on persuasive writing. We will be using fairy tales to provide inspiration for our writing, putting forward alternative view points for fairy tale characters. Our class reader this term is going to be Wild Robot by Peter Brown but we will also be using a variety of fairy tales to support our writing unit as well as a range of non-fiction texts to improve our comprehension skills.

### Maths

In maths this term Year 3 will be finishing their work on time before progressing onto data handling and fractions.

Year 4 will be finishing their work on decimals before progressing onto money and then measuring.

We will be improving our fluency with daily timetables practice.

### PHSE

This term we will be studying a unit on Relationships. We will explore and challenge the children's ideas on male and female roles, friendships, internet safety and look at how we can help others around the world.

### RE

In RE we will be exploring The Kingdom of God. This unit focuses on Pentecost and will help the children to think about how Christians may live their lives as a consequence of this story and these ideas.

### Science

Our topic this term is Plants. The children will be revising their knowledge of the parts and functions of plants. They will also explore how plants reproduce and how they transport water. They will carry out investigations to explore the above.

### Computing

We will be completing a unit called 'We are who we are' which will allow the children to improve their use of presentation software such as PowerPoint.

### PE

We will be using our REAL PE lessons to explore health and fitness. Our skills will focus on developing confidence at controlling a ball in a variety of ways.

### Art & DT

In art, we will be exploring painting through the medium of portraiture and focusing on Tudor Art as our inspiration. We will examine the themes and symbolism behind Tudor art and we will be looking at the skill of mixing paints to create tones of colour.

In DT we will be exploring our sewing skills to produce a book cover.
