





PHSE

Our topic this term is 'Being Me'. We will learn that we are all the same but different at the same time.. We will share ideas for making friends and understand what makes a good friend. We will explore the class and school rules.

Our unit this term is 'We are Astronauts'. We will explore what algorithms are; how they are implemented as programs on digital devices. They will create and debug simple programs using logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programs.

Computing

PE

Children will be introduced to footwork skill. They will explore balancing, working and taking turns to be a 'leader' and 'follower', with the follower copying the leader's footwork pattern, using speed and route, avoiding others.

RE

Our R.E. unit this term is 'How should we care for the world and for others, and why does that matter'. The children will learn 'The Good Samaritan' story, they will learn how Jewish people believe in Tzedakah. They will learn about Mother Teresa and the impact she had on the world. The children will learn about the golden rule: treat others has you wish to be treated.

Maths

Eyfs: Children will explore numbers to 10, comparing quantities and patterns. Year 1: Children will explore addition and subtraction within numbers to 10 and up to 20. Looking at number bonds which is different ways of making 10. Year 2: Children will explore numbers up to 100, looking

at place value, addition and

subtraction with numbers to

100 and multiplication and

division facts for the 2.5.10

times tables.

English

We will continue to follow the talk 4 writing process exploring a journey/wishing tale. Our focussed story will be 'How to catch a star' by Oliver Jefferies. We will hook the children into the story with looking at images from the Hubble telescope, making stars and cooking star biscuits. We will explore the story structure, looking closely at the vocabulary used. We will continue with our daily phonics lessons.

Science

In Science our unit is Animals including humans. Children will be given opportunities to learn the names of the main body parts (including head, neck, arms, elbows, legs. ears, eyes etc and also the five senses. Eyfs and year 1 will explore the five senses and how they work together. Year 2 will concentrate on making predictions, collecting data and using this to record results. Year 2 will be introduced to the idea of a fair test.

History

Our topic this term is history based. We will explore holidays and how they have changed over time. We will explore Victorian holidays in detail. Towards the end of term will hold a Victorian day, dates to follow but you may want to start thinking out Victorian dressing up outfits. We will also have a history week where we look at the history of our school.

Art/DT/Music

The children will explore the artwork of Kandinsky. Expressing their views on his art pieces. They will use primary and secondary colours to create their own masterpieces.

DT

The children will look at the difference between fruit and vegetables and design and make healthy smoothies.

Music

We will explore introducing the beat.
