Wassily Kandinsky: techniques with paint looking at colour, pattern, shape and form. Study of 'Concentric Circlesf'.

Monet: Exploring printing techniques inspired by the seascapes of Monet.

Pablo Picasso: Create 3D work using recycled materials inspired by his work. Focus on form, shape and colour.

Vincent Van Gogh: Use of drawing and paint to investigate colour and texture. Landscape paintings











Explore Impressionist painters focusing on **Paul** Cezanne. Explore colour, tone and space.



Explore the work of British landscape artist including John Constable: Create landscape paintings using acrylic focusing on paintings technique, colour and texture.

Explore the work of **Andy** Warhol focusing on his Mount Vesuvius work.






Explore the work of Frida Kahlo. Create prints and patterns inspired by her work.
