Geography- What is life like in The Alps?

PHSE

We will be studying the unit 'Healthy me!' We aim to help each other understand and support each other's physical and emotional well being.

Computing

In addition to teaching skills to support pupils across the curriculum, we will also use a class blog (that will be moderated by the class teacher) to discuss social issues.

RE

This term, we will study Christianity and Salvation. The question the pupils will be asked is: What did Jesus do to save human beings? Our school value this term is 'forgiveness.'

PE

In PE, we will focus on the social cog in Real PE. Pupils will need to continue to have their PE kits in school at all times, as dates and times could vary.

English

In English, we will start the term by completing a poetry unit on a portable paradise. We aim to encourage pupils to express their feelings and emotions, using places where they feel happiest. We will also study Information and Explanation texts.

by Allie Esin.)

Maths

Both Year Groups will continue to use Maths No Problem as a platform to develop their learning. In Year 5, we will focus on the start of Book B, which includes decimals and percentages, and position and movements. In Year 6, Book B initially covers ratio, algebra, area and perimeter and volume.

Science

Our topic this term is on Forces, and is called "Welcome to force land!"
We will focus on investigations and experiments to develop our understanding.

Geographyy and Art.

The Geography unit attempts to answer the key question, "What is life like in the Alps?" Pupils will study human and physical features, and compare these to their own locality. They will also get the opportunity to study land uses in their own village. In Art, pupils will be studying Claude Monet. In Music, we will be exploring notation.
