
Years EYFS/1 and 2 Autumn, Term 2, 2023 **Geography topic 'Where am I?'**



Maths

Eyfs: We will cover the unit on time learning the days of the week. Also looking at 2d shapes and using mathematical language to describe them. Year 1: We will continue with numbers to 20. Its especially important the children learn their number bonds to 10/20. Year 2: We will continue with learning our 2, 5 and 10's times, division and multiplication facts. We will look at measuring in cm's and metres.

English

We will continue with our daily phonic lessons. Please can all children read at home. Eyfs: The children will begin to use their phonic sounds in their writing building up to writing phrases and then sentences.

Year 1; Will begin to identify nouns and adjectives. They will learn about the different types of sentences such as command and exclamation. Year 2: They will learn about 'expanded Noun phrases' and adverbs.

PHSE

Our unit is celebrating differences. We will learn to accept that everyone is different and know how to help others solve friendship problems. We will practices using kind words and learn how to give a compliment.

RE

Our unit this term is Incarnation, looking at the birth of Jesus. Exploring and creating the First Christmas. Christians believe that Jesus was the King of Jews. We will explore the features of kingship and look at why Christians believe that Jesus was born in a stable. Year 2's will look at the Big Freeze and think about where the Incarnation fits into it.

Our unit this term, is 'We are Digital Artists'. The children will use the app the Brushes Redux. They will be inspired to create paintings inspired by the work of famous artists, for example Rothko's work and also Kandinsky's Squares with Concentric Circles.

Computing

PE

In this unit, the children will learn, develop and apply shapes and travel on the floor and apparatus through focused skill development, thematic warm-ups and games. They will be able to perform some sequencing movements on the floor.

Science

In our topic of Everyday Materials, we will explore the natural world around us, making observations. Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made. Identify and name a variety of everyday materials including wood, plastic, metal, water, and rock. We will find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

Geography

Our Geography topic this term is all about the UK. Naming the four countries that make up the UK and their capital cities. We will learn to use geographical language to describe and compare human and physical features seen in their local environment and other places in the world. We will use compass directions (North, South, East and West) to describe the location of geographical features and routes on a map.

Art/DT/Music

Art

We will explore mono printing using a variety of mediums.

DT

Over the next two terms we will make Ferris Wheels. Please remember to bring in cereal boxes.

Music

This unit builds on previous learning. All the learning is focused around one song: Ho Ho Ho - a Christmas song. The children will listening and appraise other styles of music.
