PHSE

From January, we will be using Zones of Regulation that will support us in understanding our own feelings and emotions.

Computing

In addition to teaching skills to support pupils across the curriculum, the unit we will cover this term is titled, 'We are adventure gamers.'

RE

This term, we study Creation and Science (conflict or complimentary.) This unit focuses on whether scientific discoveries can support or disagree with the creation story.

English

In English, we will study a Tale of Fear unit of work using the 'Nightmare Man' as a model text.
Our class reader for this term is 'Room 13' by Robert Swindell.

Maths

Both Year Groups will continue to use Maths No Problem as a platform to develop their learning.
In Year 5, we focus on fractions, and we will review during the midpoint of the year. In Year 6, we focus on decimals and percentages.

Science

Our topic this term is Evolution and inheritance. We will study how living things have changed over time. This unit links with our studies in Religious Education.

History, Music, Art & DT

Our History unit of work focuses on Local History and The Tudors. The unit of work will culminate in a 'Tudor day.'
In Music, we will be rehearsing and performing in preparation for the Big Sing in March. More details will follow shortly.
Our Art and DT unit is called 'Brave Colour' whereby the work of the artist Hans Holbein and his famous portrait of Henry VIII will be studied, looking at how colour depicts mood and creates atmosphere.
