



## World War II Class Two Summer Term 1 2024



### English

This term's focus will be on 'Abstract Image Poetry'. We will be working towards creating our own poems and doing lots of short bursts of writing along the way.

Our class reader will be Wildspark by Vashti Hardy.

### History

This term we will be looking at World War II and the impact this had on Great Britain.

### Maths

Over this half term, year 3 will be looking at time, graphs and fractions.  
Year 4 will be looking at decimals, money and measure  
Year 5 will be looking at percentages, geometry, position and movement.  
Year 6 will be learning about area, volume and position and movement. They will also be recapping prior learning ready for their SATs

### PHSE

We will be looking at 'Relationships' during PSHE lessons.  
Our school value this term is Service.

### RE

This term, we will be looking at the unit Kingdom of God: What kind of King is Jesus?  
This will involve looking at how to apply Christian values in the world today and the story of Pentecost.

### Science

Our topic this term is 'Living things and their habitats: Classification.'  
This involves learning about various animals, insects and plants and looking at how they are classified into different groups.  
Year 3 and 4 will be learning about living things and their environments. This will involve classification, ecology and lots of studies of different living things.

### Computing

The unit we will focus on this term is: 'We are inventors.' During this unit the children will be designing a product and learning about computer aided design, and have the opportunity to learn to code.

### PE

P.E lessons will continue for Class 2 each Friday. We will be learning cricket skills and archery this half term. Children will also be undertaking PE sessions with Rhino Sports every Monday. This will alternate, weekly between Lower Key-Stage 2 and Upper Key-Stage 2.

### Art & DT

Our art topic this term is called: 'Take a seat.' This will involve looking at how chair designs have progressed over the centuries, to understand how furniture can reflect or define the age in which it was made.

In D&T, our topic is 'Waistcoats,' which involves designing and creating a waistcoat.
