



## EYFS, Years 1 and 2 Summer Term 1, 2025 How did we learn to fly



### Maths

Through out the term we will be looking at the following areas of mathematics:

**EYFS:** We will concentrate on counting forwards and backwards up to 20. Halving and sharing and volume and capacity.

**Year 1:** Working on numbers to 40, multiplication, division and fractions.

**Year 2:** Working on money, 2d and 3d shapes. Learning about fractions, volume and word problems.

### English

**EYFS:** The children will explore a range of stories. They will write complete sentences using capital letters and full stops.

**Year 1:** The children will understand a 5 part story: opening, build-up, problem, resolution, ending. Including conjunctions and suffixes in their writing.

**Year 2:** They will learn to include subordinating conjunctions: that/while/when/because/then/to /until. And begin to include speech marks in their creative writing.

### Science

Our Science topic this term is an Introduction to Plants. The children will identify plants and their features. Recall some of the roles that flowering plant parts have and name some trees and their parts. Identify similarities and differences between deciduous and evergreen leaves. The children will recall that seeds and bulbs come from plants and recognise that seeds need water for growth.

### History

Our topic is called 'How did we learn to fly?'. This unit Identify important events surrounding the history of flight. We will explore the significant event that has changed the lives of others. We will ask questions about people and events in the past, use primary sources to find out about people and events in the past. The children will create a timeline of significant events and people.

### DT/Music

#### D&T

Our topic this term is Cooking and nutrition. The children will describe basic characteristics of fruit and vegetables. They will prepare and make a smoothie.

#### Music

Our unit is: Singing (Theme: On this island). We will learn folk songs and creating sounds to represent three contrasting landscapes: seaside, countryside and city.

### PSHE

Our topic this term is 'Safety and the changing body'. The children will learn the names of parts of the body, including those of the private parts for their gender. Explain the PANTS rule. They will understand how to keep safe near roads and explain the rules for crossing the road.

### RE

In this unit, pupils will learn about the 'Gospel' and the good news of forgiveness, peace and love that Christians believe Jesus brings. Children will learn about Matthew the Tax Collector and how Christians believe that Jesus offers forgiveness, looking at their heart rather than what they have done in the past.

### Computing

Our topic is Digital Imagery, the children will learn how to plan a pictorial story using photographic images in sequence. They will explain how to take clear photos, using a device, edit photos by cropping, filtering and resizing. The children will learn to search for and import images from the internet. They will explain what to do if something makes them uncomfortable online.

### PE

Our PE topic is focused on Striking and fielding game. The children will be put into two, one, the batting team, try to score points and the other, the fielding team, try to stop the batting team from scoring. Examples of striking and fielding games include cricket and rounders.
