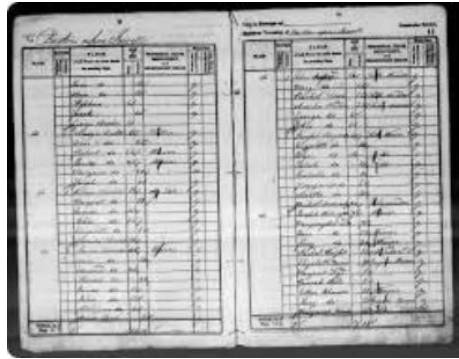


History – What can the census tell us about local areas?

Maths

Both Year Groups will continue to use Maths No Problem as a platform to develop their learning. In Year 5, we focus on Numbers to 1000 and applying all four operations in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division units. In Year 6, we focus on Numbers to 10 million, the four operations and fractions.

Science

Our topic this term is 'Classification – big and small' which looks at the Linnaeus classification system. This will then lead on to understand how vertebrates, invertebrates and plants are classified.

History, Music, Art & DT, MFL

Our History unit is called 'What can the census tell us about local areas?' In Design, the topic we are studying is called, 'Making waistcoats.' In Music, we are studying 'looping and remixing.' In MFL, we will study French transport.
