

**Geography – Why do oceans matter?**  
**Years 5 & 6**  
**Spring Term 2 2026**



**PHSE**

Focus on Citizenship, learning about physical and mental health, self-care, and strategies for resilience.

**Computing**

Pupils will be introduced to Python, writing simple programs and experimenting with coding logic.

**RE**

Considering the question, What difference does the resurrection make to Christians?, pupils will explore Christian beliefs and their significance in daily life.

**PE**

Developing teamwork and coordination through basketball, with drills, matches, and skill-building exercises.  
Swimming will continue on a Tuesday. Please ensure full federation PE kits are in school everyday.

**English**

Pupils will write recount diary entries, learning to capture personal experiences with detail, emotion, and structure.

**Maths**

Year 6 will focus on SATs preparation, revisiting key KS2 concepts to build confidence and fluency.

Year 5 will explore decimals, percentages, and geometry, applying their skills to problem-solving activities.

**Science**

Pupils will learn about circuits, batteries, and switches, building and testing their own electrical circuits to see how electricity flows.

**Geography, Music & Art**

Exploring Why do oceans matter?, children will investigate the importance of oceans to life on Earth and consider human impacts.  
In Drawing: Expressing Ideas, pupils will develop skills to communicate their thoughts and emotions visually through various drawing techniques.  
Pupils will continue with Big Sing, finalising their pieces ready to perform as a big group on the theatre.
